This red is a blend of Columbia Valley Rhone varietals, matured for almost two years in third and fourth-fill French oak barrels.

The 2014 vintage was very warm. Syrah achieved remarkably rich, ripe flavors: ripe plum, black cherry, blackberry. The Grenache in this blend contributed red fruit character (strawberry, raspberry). The Mourvedre brings spiciness and black fruit backbone. A small amount of Viognier was co-fermented with one lot of Syrah; this contributes a light floral note to the wine’s aromas.

93% of this wine was sourced from Walla Walla Valley AVA vineyards. The remaining 7% was sourced from the Horse Heaven Hills AVA.
